A Report on
'Book Review Competition'

Event Overview: Four Students of our institute, participated in Book Review Competition, organized by Amity B School, Pune. There were total 51 student participants from various institutions. The competition was a platform for students to showcase their analytical skills, critical thinking, and the ability to articulate thoughts on a variety of books, spanning both fiction and non-fiction genres.

Our students, Mr. Yashraj Tawaskar, Ms. Sanika Kedare, Mr. Deepak Dhiwar and Ms. Devika Pardeshi represented the institute for 'Book Review Competition' conducted by Amity Business School. The students presented the reviews of books, presenting their insights, understanding, and critical analysis about the books through their deliberations.

The institute conducted in-house Book Review Competition under the guidance of the Director, Dr. Bharat Kasar. The event was aimed at selecting students who would represent the institute at the prestigious Book Review Competition held by Amity B School, Pune.

The in-house competition aimed to encourage students to engage with literary works critically and enhance their presentation skills. It also served as a platform to identify and groom the students for the inter-collegiate competition.

All faculties including Director Sir, were present and critically evaluated the presentation of participants. On the basis of the evaluation, four entries were nominated for the competition at Amity B school, Pune.

Competition Structure at Amity B School:

The inter-collegiate competition at Amity B School was conducted in two rounds. 51 participants from various B Schools participated in the competition. Both fiction and non-fiction books were reviewed by the participants, adding diversity to the competition and showcasing a broad spectrum of literary understanding.

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12 students were selected for the final round based on the quality of their reviews, presentation skills, and depth of analysis. Mr. Deepak Dhiwar, one of our institute students was shortlisted for the final round.

Mr. Deepak Dhiwar was awarded the consolation prize in the final round. His performance was recognized for its merit, highlighting his ability to critically evaluate the book and present his review effectively. He reviewed the book, “Think and Grow rich” by Napoleon Hill.

The participation of our students, particularly Mr. Deepak Dhiwar’s achievement, showcased the zeal, enthusiasm and talent of our institute students. The competition provided an excellent platform for the students to engage with literary works, hone their critical thinking skills, and gain recognition for their efforts.
