Report on
Two Days State Level Workshop
on
"Implementation of National Education Policy 2020:
Multidisciplinary Education"**

Date: Jan. 20 & 21, 2023

The National Education Policy 2020 is a comprehensive framework for elementary education to higher education as well as vocational training in both rural and urban India. This Policy proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is aligned with the aspirational goals of 21st century education, while building upon India's traditions and value systems.

Camp Education Society's Rasiklal M. Dhariwal Institute of Management conducted Two Day's State Level Workshop in association with Savitribai Phule Pune University (QIP) on "Implementation of National Education Policy 2020: Multidisciplinary Education" on 20th Jan. 2023 & 21st Jan. 2023.

The objectives of the Workshop were:

- To create awareness of the holistic nature of NEP 2020 that aims to address many growing developmental imperatives of our country.
- To understand NEP 2020 Policy that proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is aligned with the aspirational goals of 21st century education.
- The workshop explored the challenges and opportunities for HEI during NEP 2020 implementation and enabled the participants to effectively implement it.

The two days' workshop was inaugurated by Shri. Nandkumar Nikam, Secretary, Shirur Shikshan Prasarak Mandal. Hon. Shri. Walchand Sancheti, Chairman, Camp Education Society presided over the inauguration function. Hon. Shri. Baburao Jawalekar, Secretary, Camp Education Society graced the function with his auspicious presence. The inauguration function started with the Saraswati Pujan followed by felicitation of honourable dignitaries. Director, Dr. Bharat Kasar in his opening remarks briefed about the activities about the intention of theme of the workshop.

Shri. Nandkumar Nikam in his inaugural speech briefed about the evolution of Education Policies in the pre & post-independence and the reforms made recommended in Wardha Commission – Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishna Committee – D S Kothari and J P Nayak Committee to the latest NEP 2020 Education Policy. Hon. Chairman, Shri Walchand Sancheti, discussed about the issues that need to be pondered on while implementing NEP 2020 and motivated the participants to take advantage of the expertise of resource persons of the workshop.

Dr. Parag Kalkar, Dean, Faculty of Commerce & Management, Member, Academic Council and Senate, SPPU, talked about the quality and quantity of higher education –planned target for NEP – 2020 for GER (Graduate Enrolment Ratio) is 50 % from 26 % and about 3.05 crore students would be added and there would be a requirement of doubling the number of educational institutes. He explained the provisions of multiple entry and exit provided in NEP

– 2020, completion of 10 skill-based credits to be completed by any student at any level of certification / Diploma / Degree.

Dr. Kuldip Charak, Director, Dr. D. Y. Patil Institute of Management Studies, Pune discussed about the importance given to holistic education in NEP 2020. He stressed on learning rather than teaching and discussed about all round development of the students as human beings focussed in NEP – 2020.

Dr. G. K. Shirude, Vice Chancellor, Shri Balaji University, Pune, discussed about how the alignment of NEP 2020 philosophy is in line with philosophy described by Swami Vivekanand and explained how NEP 2020 will benefit to achieve the outcome of education in man making, life making and character making rather than job seeking.

In the panel discussion, the panellists, Dr. Abhay Kulkarni, Dr. Shivaji Mundhe, Dr. Kirti Dharwadkar, Dr. Ganesh Rao and Dr. Chetan Chaudhari discussed about NEP – 2020 from various perspectives that included whether the students and parents be able handle the problem of plenty, how ABC in NEP 2020 help students to complete their education at their own pace, challenges that educational institutes and teachers would be facing in implementation of NEP – 2020, etc.

Opportunities, challenges, problems, and roles of various stakeholders related to implementation of NEP 2020 were discussed and resource persons shared a lot of suggestions for successful implementation of NEP – 2020.

Lot of brain storming and discussions happened during the two days of workshop on NEP 2020: Multidisciplinary Education. Over 70 participants from colleges / institutes from SPPU and outside SPPU benefitted from the workshop.

The 2 Days State Level Workshop was successfully conducted and concluded under the guidance of our Chief Convener, Director, Dr. Bharat Kasar, Convener, Dr. Asita Ghewari, Prof. Rajesh Londhe, Prof. Ritu Kasliwal, Prof. Ashwini Chavan and the support of non-teaching staff of the institute. The students of MBA I and II year actively volunteered the workshop.
