Workshop on "Derivative Fundamentals"

Derivatives are powerful financial tools that can be used for risk management, speculation, and arbitrage. By raising awareness of derivatives at an early stage, students can gain a foundational understanding of how these financial instruments work, their potential benefits, and the risks involved. This early knowledge can serve as a valuable asset as they advance in their academic and professional management careers, making them better informed about the financial world.

With this objective in mind, the institute organized a dedicated workshop for postgraduate and final-year undergraduate students from the vicinity, many of whom are on the verge of starting their professional careers. An one hour workshop on "derivative fundamentals" sponsored by National Commodity Derivative Exchange of India (NCDEX) was organized on October 22, 2024 by the institute.

The workshop began with opening remarks from the Director, Dr. Bharat Kasar, who encouraged students to actively engage in the session and highlighted the importance of understanding the fundamental concepts of derivatives. The workshop was conducted by Mr. Rohit Warman, NCDEX Empanelled Expert, followed by a question-answer session which facilitated the student participants to clarify their doubts.
